DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

Bread Lock Park and the Museum at Bread Lock Park are projects developed under an agreement between The Highlands Project and the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders. Highlands works with Warren County youth in directed and educational community service projects on Saturday mornings from 8:00 a.m. until noon. The results of these projects can be seen daily at Bread Lock Park and include a full-sized Morris Canal boat replica and a section of restored canal. The museum includes models and displays of Warren County history.

The park and museum are located on Route 57, west of New Village at mile marker 4.
