County Route 519 Southbound to Close for Bridge Repair

(LOPATCONG TWP., NJ – June 6, 2019) – County Route 519 southbound, immediately south of State Route 57 at the railroad tunnel, will be closed to traffic as of June 17, 2019 for a bridge repair project.

County Route 519 southbound traffic will be detoured onto State Route 57 west to Strykers Road and proceed south to rejoin County Route 519 near the Warren County Library's Southwest Branch.

The northbound tunnel of County Route 519 will be closed for the reconstruction of Bridge #15017. The northbound traffic of County Route 519 will be directed into the southbound tunnel. The project completion date is scheduled for November 30, 2019.

The photo shows the south side of the tunnels, where the Lopatcong Creek runs through the tunnel on the right beneath the northbound lane of the county road. Northbound traffic - like the car shown here - will be diverted into the southbound tunnel on the left while the northbound side is closed. Southbound traffic will be detoured to Strykers Road.



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
