



Warren County Government: What's Open and Closed

The following Warren County offices and services are closed until further notice, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Warren County Library, all branches
- Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Warren County
- Warren County Department of Education / County Superintendent of Schools
- Planning Department (land development review will continue)
- Land Preservation Department / Division of Cultural & Historic Affairs
- County-operated museums Shippen Manor, Warren Heritage Museum at Bread Lock Park, Jim and Mary Lee Museum at Plane 9 West.

Other Warren County offices and essential services are continuing to function, but **all facilities are closed to the public**. Contact the office you need either by telephone or email. Contact information is available at:

All visits to the Warren County Correctional Center are temporarily suspended. Please check back for updates to the visitation policy.

Meetings of the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders will continue unless there is a notification of cancellation. Provisions for public access will be announced on a meeting-by-meeting basis through the Warren County website and the County's social media platforms.

Meetings of all other boards, committees and advisory groups have been cancelled.

Warren County parks and open space properties remain open to the public, but social distancing is urged: avoid crowded public places and maintain about 6 feet of distance from others when possible.
